I, Warren P. Rickard of Plymouth, Plymouth County, Massachusetts, for consideration paid, grant to the Inhabitants of the County of Plymouth, with quitclaim covenants, the land in Plymouth described as follows:- A certain parcel of wood-land lying southwesterly from Warren Wells Brook, so called, and bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the Northeastly corner of the granted premises; thence running South $79^{\circ} 47'$ West 31 rods and .05 links; thence North $90^{\circ} 11'$ West 27 rods; thence North $89^{\circ} 45'$ West 59 rods and .05 links; thence South $5^{\circ} 03'$ East 153 rods and 15 links; thence South $39^{\circ} 55'$ West 27 rods and 15 links; thence South $56^{\circ} 30'$ East 72 rods; thence North $5^{\circ} 7^{\circ} 30'$ East 69 rods and 10 links; thence North $21^{\circ} 24'$ West 14 rods; thence South $80^{\circ} 30'$ West 7 rods and 10 links; thence North $53^{\circ} 15'$ East 17 rods; thence North 29° East 7 rods; thence North $9^{\circ} 30'$ East 14 rods and .06 links; thence North 19° East 15 rods and .08 links; thence North $10^{\circ} 30'$ East 7 rods; thence North 78° West 1 rod and 15 links to the point of beginning see plan entitled, "Plan of wood-lot lying southwesterly from Warrens Wells Brook belonging to William T. Davis, Esq., containing 103 acres and 20 rods, surveyed by John Harlow and April 15, 1854." For my title see deed from Winslow Rickard and Mary Torrey dated February 23, 1882, and recorded with Plymouth County Deeds, Book 483, page 144. Said premises are conveyed subject to an easement to maintain a line of poles given by the said grantor to the Plymouth Electric Light Co., by deed dated September 19, 1914, and recorded with Plymouth County Deeds, Book 1195, page 341.
